Subject: **Autonomy to the College for all the courses conducted at G.H. Raisoni College of Engineering regarding**

Madam,

In connection with the above reference and subject, I would like to inform you that your Institute was accorded autonomous status vide Notification No. 22-1/2010(AC) dated 25th May, 2010 of UGC and subsequent Notification by Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University vide Notification No. BCUD/2010/1687 dated 4.6.2010. Accordingly your request to allow your Institution to implement autonomy for all the Engineering Courses as well as other courses approved by the AICTE and affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University has been permitted by the authorities of the University and I am directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to inform you that the autonomy has to be exercised under the following contents:

1. The examinations of all regular, Ex-students (failure) and students having ATKT of all the Years of all the Courses will be conducted by your Institution from the Winter Session of 2010-11 onwards at a time as per the Directions, Ordinances, Statutes of the University governing these courses and Scheme of markings for each course conducted by your Institute. Conduct of examination includes paper-setting, moderation, conduct of examinations, valuation, moderation of the result and declaration of the results. The college should also ensure the process of Revaluation as per the Directions/Ordinances of the University in force.
2. The awarded marks on earlier examinations for all the above categories of students of all Years as maintained by the University will be transferred to your College on request from which the data can be utilized in order to generate the new mark-sheets and declare the results accordingly.
3. The format of the mark-sheet that will be given to the students from the session 2010-11 will be decided jointly by the University and the concerned authorities of your College.
4. The format of the degree certificate also will be jointly decided by the University and competent Authority of your College for awarding the certificates to passed out students during the ensuing Convocation of the University.

You are requested to take necessary action in this regard and inform the students accordingly and keep informing the University the development taking place at your end.
